# Galtec Washing Up Liquid

### GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

**WASHING UP LIQUID** is a neutral general purpose liquid detergent, incorporating a blend of surface active agents and inorganic materials, designed for cleaning operations where light organic contaminants and general grime have to be removed. **WASHING UP LIQUID** is ideal for such operations as hand dishwashing, hard surface cleaning and pressure washing. **WASHING UP LIQUID** can also be used in all food areas for general cleaning followed by a rinse and sanitise using Galtec Suresan.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

**WASHING UP LIQUID** should be used as follows:

<u>Heavy soiling</u>	<u>Medium soiling</u>	<u>Light soiling</u>
Dilute 1:5 to 1:10 with water	Dilute 1:15 to 1:20 with water	Dilute 1:25 to 1:100 with water

Apply by brushing, wiping, immersion or pressure spray.
